

## Milton "Tom" Wenner

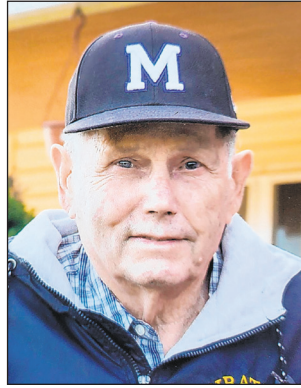
Milton T. Wenner, "Tom", 91, of Knoxville, MD passed from this life on Tuesday, June 2, 2026.
